

ICAR-CRIJAF organized training programme on “Improved Retting Technology for Better Quality Jute Fibre” under SCSP

A three days training programme on “Improved Retting Technology for Better Quality Jute Fibre” was organized by ICAR-CRIJAF during 07.06.2023 to 09.06.2023 for the scheduled caste community of Chakdah block, Nadia district under SCSP. A total of 30 farmers participated in the programme. During the programme, the farmers learned about the different aspects of improved retting technologies of jute in West Bengal particularly (a) Improved retting with Crijaif Sona, (b) Pest and disease management of jute, (c) Practical classes on In-situ and free flowing retting technology and pond based integrated farming system, (d) Use of advanced machinery in jute cultivation, (e) Educational visit to the Fibre museum. The farmers actively interacted with the resource persons regarding the problems faced by them in jute retting and was satisfied with the solutions advised by the experts. The three days training was ended with a valedictory session of the trainees and scientists. The programme was organized by Dr. Gouranga Kar and Dr. Bijan Majumdar (Course Directors) and Dr R. K.
