

ICAR-CRIJAF organized training programme on “Scope of Goat Farming in Enhancing Rural Livelihood in Tribal Area” under TSP

A three days training programme on “Scope of Goat Farming in Enhancing Rural Livelihood in Tribal Area” was organized at ICAR-CRIJAF during 19.12.2022 to 21.12.2022 for the tribal community of Selarhat and Sewli Telinipara village, North 24 Parganas under Tribal Sub Plan. A total of 15 tribal farmers participated in the programme. During the programme, the farmers learned about the different aspects of scientific Goat farming, viz. scope of goat farming in West Bengal, breeding, feeding, housing, health care and diseases management of goat farming, value addition in goat milk and chevon. The farmers actively interacted with the resource persons regarding the problems faced by them in goat farming and was satisfied with the solutions advised by the experts.
