

2 days training on Natural Farming for Resource Conservation and Quality Crop

Production on 12th & 13th August, 2024

A two days training program on Natural Farming for resource conservation and quality crop production” was organized on 12th & 13th August, 2024 at Bapur Village by KVK, North 24 Parganas (Addl.), ICAR-CRIJAF, Barrackpore. The programme was organized through interaction-based training sessions covering various topics delivered by different Subject Matter Specialists from KVK. Various aspects of natural farming viz., methods of preparation of bio-stimulants, nutrient management approaches, pest and disease management and Integrated Farming system models were discussed during the training program. The training also included the method demonstration on preparation of bio stimulants for natural farming, preparation of neem-based pesticides, installation of sticky traps and pheromone traps, etc.
